



Sliding Scale Discount

Central Virginia Health Services, Inc. provides services without regard for a person’s ability to pay. We also accept most insurance plans.

Sliding Scale Fee Discount

We use a sliding fee scale to determine financial assistance “discounts” based on the family or individual’s income and family size. The sliding scale discount is available to patients whose family income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (see below). Based on family size and income, you are assigned a slide level of A, B, C, D, or E, with A being the slide receiving the greatest discount.

What you pay:

Patients receiving the A slide (at or below 100% of Federal Poverty Level) pay a nominal fee. For each level above, you pay a set amount.

Accepted proofs of income:

- ✓ Recent pay stubs (showing one month)
- ✓ Tax return from previous year
- ✓ Unemployment benefits
- ✓ Letter from employer
- ✓ Government benefits (SS, SSI, VA, Disability)
- ✓ Support letter (if unemployed or homeless)

Benefits of the Slide

- Keeps cost of health care affordable
- Sliding fee also applies to medications prescribed by CVHS providers and filled by the CVHS Pharmacy.*
- May be used even if you have insurance
 - Helpful for high deductible plans
 - Helpful for plans with high co-pays
- Helps families balance health care costs and other expenses

* Patients may qualify for additional pharmacy discount programs

You must submit all incomes from everyone in the household.
